What we do

Southwark and Lewisham Centres provide specialist legal advice, casework and representation in employment, discrimination, planning, public law, education housing, asylum/immigration and welfare Rights Law, and mainly for people who live or work in Southwark, Lewisham and surrounding Boroughs.

Every year we help over 1,000 people who could not otherwise afford to receive legal services. Our service is free and of high quality. Things are getting more and more difficult for the people we see mainly because of the inequality crisis, cuts to welfare benefits, the shortage of affordable housing and the hostile environment for migrants.

The Law Centre is committed to taking positive action to fight discrimination and inequality in every aspect of our work. We prioritise cases which involve the prevention of homelessness, destitution, discrimination, breaches of human rights and poverty. We provide training on legal rights and legal support to local advice and community agencies. We are a non-political organisation but we campaign responsibly to influence law, policy and practice and promote human and civil rights.

We are a registered charity and are governed by a trustee board of local residents.
